



Driving Women's golf

**Four Counties Junior Girls' Championships
(Conditions updated 18.02.05)**

Leicestershire – Lincolnshire – Northamptonshire – Nottinghamshire

1. Competitors must be under 18 years of age on 1st January in the year of entry to the Championships. Date of birth should be on the entry form.
2. Handicap Limit 35
3. Open to Leicestershire – Lincolnshire – Northamptonshire – Nottinghamshire
4. No regulation about birth, but must be a member of a golf club in one of the four counties
5. Play should be in 2's where possible and Handicap Certificates must be shown
6. All competitors must play with a ball named on the current list of conforming golf balls as issued by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews. (This will be checked on the first tee by the starter along with the number of clubs)
7. Drug Abuse: a competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Any competitor infringing this condition may be disqualified.
8. NO TROLLEY PULLERS ALLOWED – PENALTY DISQUALIFICATION.
9. LATE ON THE TEE: A competitor arriving up to 5 mins late will be penalised 2 shots, beyond 5 minutes – PENALTY DISQUALIFICATION. (Extenuating circumstances at the Organiser's discretion)
10. Prizes
 - a. Best Gross Score to be Champion and holds Four Counties Salver: (If there is a tie on best gross the players to play sudden death gross on suitable holes e.g. 1,2, 17, 18 dependant upon the course); 2nd Gross; 3rd Gross
 - b. Best Gross Under15 years old on the 1 Jan in the year of the Championship
 - c. Nett: 1st Nett holds Trophy – Four Counties Cup; 2nd Nett; 3rd Nett; 4th Nett and if large entry 5th Nett.
 - d. Teams
Scratch Team: 1 per County, 2 scores to count out of 3. Winning County Scratch Team holds Northamptonshire Quaiche (donated by Mrs Stephanie Wright)
Nett Teams: Best 2 Nett Teams of 3 (1 team of 2 if only 2 entries from a County)
Maximum 2 teams (6 players 2 x 3; 1 x 3, 1 x 2; 4 players 2 x 2). 1st Team prize: 2nd Team prize.
Individual players maybe nominated for both scratch and handicap team events BUT may only be included in one scratch and one handicap team. In the event of a tie for the handicap team competition the winners will be decided by the combined nett total of the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes of the two cards making up the team score.
 - e. In the case of one person winning both trophies the player takes both trophies but only one prize (Exception: a team prize). Prizes are not labelled unless vouchers are given.
11. Entry Fee : £5.00 Value of prizes decided according to numbers of entries expected or sponsorship received. Each County to provide £30.00 to be sent in advance of the day to organising CJO. (Contributions to be reviewed every 4 years)
12. Championship is held in rotation around the Four Counties and a meeting with the Four Counties Junior Organisers will be held at this Championship (onus on the CJO to be present or to send a deputy).
