### **Conditions of Entry**

1. The Championship shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and with the Local Rules of the club.
2. The format will be 36 holes medal play.
3. The handicap limit will be 36.
4. The championship will be played from LGU tees.
5. All competitors must be members of club affiliated to the Lincolnshire Ladies County Golf Association and be under 18 years of age the date of the 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the same year. They shall have amateur status in accordance with the current amateur status regulations of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
6. There will be an U18 gross trophy and the winner will be the U18 County Champion.
7. All competitors under 16 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the same year will be eligible for the U16 Gross trophy and the winner will be the U16 County Champion.
8. All competitors under 14 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the same year will be eligible for the Imps Cup (Gross trophy) and the winner will be the U14 County Champion.
9. The U18, U16 and U14 Champions will be expected to represent Lincolnshire at the Champion of Champions Tournament to be held later in the season. (If the U18 County Champion is under 16 years of age they will represent Lincolnshire in the U16 Champion of Champions Tournament and the next best gross of a girl aged between 16 and 18 will represent Lincolnshire in the U18 Champion of Champions Tournament. If the U16 County Champion is under 14 years of age they will represent Lincolnshire in the U14 Champion of Champions Tournament and the next best gross of a girl aged between 14 and 16 will represent Lincolnshire in the U16 Champion of Champions Tournament). The County will pay all expenses for the representatives in Champion of Champions Tournament.
10. The Best Nett winner will hold the Jenny Wren Trophy.
11. The winner of each trophy shall hold the trophy for 1 year and be responsible for engraving and making sure that the trophy is available for next year's championship. An individual can hold more than one trophy.
12. In the event of ties the winner will be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes in that order. If two or more competitors are still tied the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off over predetermined holes near the clubhouse.

### **The Competition**

1. **HANDICAP CERTIFICATES** must be shown.
2. Competitors are to collect their cards 20 minutes prior to their tee times and be at the tee 5 minutes before their start time.
3. No caddies or trolley pullers are allowed.
4. Competitors are not permitted to ride on motorised buggies.
5. It is obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball, which is named, in the current R&A or USGA list of approved 1.68 golf balls. No xxx-outs allowed.
6. Drug abuse – a competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. A list of permitted drugs is available from UK Sport. Penalty – disqualification (for infringing this condition or refusing to take a drugs test).
7. Entry forms, together with the entry fee are to be received by the Championship organiser no later than the closing date shown on the entry form.
8. Competitors to adhere to the dress code on and off the course. Competitors to change after play.
9. Strictly **NO MOBILES** to be used on the course or in the clubhouse. (They may be used in the car park)
10. All players are strongly recommended to use a trolley and not to carry their clubs.
11. All spectators are requested to stay off the fairways and not to speak or advise the competitors in anyway whilst playing in the championships.

**For breach of any of the above competition rules  
Penalty – disqualification**
