These changes will be in force from 1 January 2019. Whilst the majority of the rules remain, some changes are in place around dropping the ball, taking relief and balls lost or out of bounds. Time available to search for lost balls is also reduced to three minutes.

Toft Ladies League team have done it again! On Wednesday 12 September the team travelled to South Kyme Gold Club as 2018 Lincolnshire League Division 1 South champions to play against Elsham B, the winners of Division 1 North.

Such a clash between two champion teams was always going to be tightly fought, and so it proved. The many supporters and representatives from Lincolnshire Ladies County Golf Association were thrilled to watch a match that swung one way, and then the other.

Mairead Scott and Cathy Lee set out first, halved the first five holes in a match that neither side was ever more than one up but unfortunately the Toft pair lost on the final green. One down. Hard on their heels came the formidable pairing of Lorraine Robinson and Mandy Lees. They took an early lead, then slowly built on it throughout the round, to record a clear victory 6 and 4. The third, Sandie Streets and Lisa Hollingsworth had the misfortune to come up against one Elsham lady who played well below handicap on the day, and a pair that dovetailed beautifully. Toft were one down again. The fourth pair however, Lady Captain Louise Bradley and Alison Ravenhill, were in unstoppable form and cruised to an outstanding "dog licence" win, 7 and 6. All square.
